- Assisting in the inspection of Waukesha natural gas compression engines by using a borescope and physical diagnosis Resulting in the installation of a new crankshaft and top-end rebuild, Including rocker assembly.
- Full Waukesha engine disassembly and engine block removal; swapped over camshaft, cam gear, oil lines and other ancillary components before hoisting and installing back in position.
- Oil changes and timing adjustments on natural gas compression engines are part of my frequent preventative maintenance duties with a journeyperson.
- Full retrofitting and installation of new 4" and 6" diameter piping systems in an exterior process building. Assisted contracted welder with removing, rigging and reinstalling of new vertical and horizontal pipe systems and valves running from the exterior into the building and existing structure.
- Completed a rebuild of Vogelsang rotary lobe pump with minimal assistance; from cleaning/prepping of chassis to full replacement of bearings, mechanical seals, shaft installation, sealing of the wet end and reinstallation of lobes.
- Completed a lobe replacement on the rotary lobe pump in place in the field

- Monthly Vibration and Oil/Viscosity Analysis on critical equipment within the treatment process. Use of SKF intrinsically safe
 devices for data capture into the SKF Pulse application for trend monitoring. Oil samples were captured and sent to Fluid Life
 for testing.
